## **DETAILS OF PROFESSIONAL TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:**

### **1. February 2001 to date, Consultant Pedodontist, Armed Forces Hospital King Abdulaziz Naval Base, P.O. Box 413, Jubail 31951 Saudi Arabia.**

The Armed Forces Hospital (Ministry of Defence and Aviation) has a well equipped and large dental department, providing dental treatment to military personnel and their dependents. The hospital has excellent outpatient and inpatient management facilities in all medical disciplines.

My job responsibilities included, the provision of treatment which encompasses all the medical, surgical, restorative and preventive treatment of oral diseases; injuries and deficiencies that come within the field of dentistry for children. All the cooperative and manageable patients were usually given dental treatment in dental clinic eg – extractions, restorations, crowns, pediatric endodontics patients were given the comprehensive dental treatment under general anesthesia (three sessions per week). I was also responsible for postgraduate dentists during their internship period. This includes clinical supervision, training and consultation clinics.

### **2. May 1999 to February 2001, Consultant Pedodontist, King Saud Hospital, Unayzah Saudi Arabia.**

King Saud Hospital belongs to ministry of health and is a tertiary care hospital with 345 beds capacity. This well equipped large hospital provides healthcare facilities for patients of all medical specialities including dentistry. The dental department was providing the treatment by specialists/ consultants to the patients referred from primary healthcare centers of ministry of health. My clinical work included, comprehensive dental treatment under G.A. for uncooperative, medically compromised and handicapped patients. Routinely the cooperative pedodontic patients were treated in dental clinic. A wide variety of Pediatric dental procedures were performed during this job, which included management of dental emergencies in children extractions, space maintainers, crowns, restorations and interceptive orthodontics.

### **3. February 1999 to May 1999, Assistant Prof. / Consultant / Head of Department of Pedodontics, Children Hospital and Institute of Child Health Lahore – Pakistan.**

This governmental institute has been specifically designed to provide latest and state of the art healthcare facilities to children. (Out-patients and in-patients management). The large well equipped dental department provides all sorts of pediatric oral and maxillo-facial surgery, orthodontics, preventive and pediatric dentistry.

My job responsibilities consisted of consultation clinics, comprehensive dental treatment under G.A. and routine pediatric dental procedures in dental clinic.

**4. October 1995 to November 1998 Postgraduate student (M.D.S Course) University Rene DESCARTES Paris V France and affiliated hospitals. A. Robert Debre Hospital Paris. B. Hotel Dieu Hospital Paris. C. Albert chenevier Hospital Paris.**

The clinical research training programme consisted of rotation in three hospitals affiliated with the University of Rene DESCARTES Paris V. I have wide clinical and research experience during this M.D.S. course (Pedodontics). The clinical work consisted of attendance of consultation clinics (with professors), treating the patients for routine pediatric dental procedures and clinical training for comprehensive dental treatment under G.A. The clinical training also included the treatment and management of patients with facial deformities. eg cleft lip and palate, facial growth dishormonies. I also provided the training and opportunities for case presentations at seminars / weekly clinical meetings. The research work was completed and submitted to the university as requirement of M.D.S. At the end of course the written and clinical examination were held and later the degree was awarded after the acceptance of M.D.S. research thesis.

**5. October 1994 to October 1996. Postgraduate student (MSc Course) College de Medicine des Hopitaux de Paris and Robert Debre Hospital Paris France.**

I gained a lot of clinical and research experience during this M.Sc. Course (Pediatric Stomatology) which help me later to get admission in M.D.S. programme. I completed a research project as part of requirement for MSc. and later this thesis was accepted by the college after successful written and clinical examinations.
