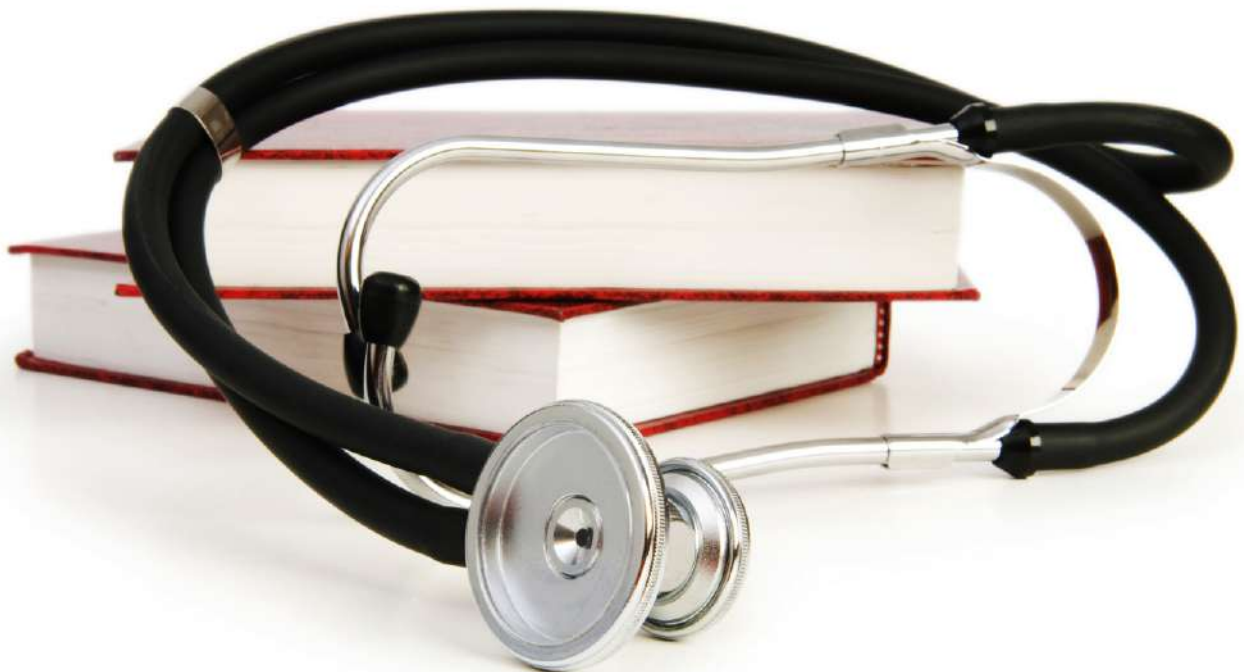
OUR MISSION

The concept of the “seven-star doctor” is proposed as an ideal profile of a doctor possessing a combination of aptitudes to carry out the wide range of services that health settings must deliver to meet the requirements of relevance, quality, cost-effectiveness and equity in health. The seven sets of attributes of the “seven-star doctor” are summarized as below:

The Seven-Star Doctor

The expected generic competencies in a medical graduate are as follows:

- Skillful
- Knowledgeable
- Community Health Promoter
- Critical Thinker
- Professional
- Scholar
- Leader and Role Model

A 'seven-star doctor' graduate from Pakistan Medical Council should be able to demonstrate attributes as mentioned.

SKILLFUL (CLINICAL, COGNITIVE AND PATIENT CARE SKILLS)

Competent medical graduates require sound clinical skills grounded in knowledge of patient-centered care. They should be able to demonstrate that they can:

- Take a focused history
- Perform physical and psychological examinations
- Formulate a provisional diagnosis
- Order appropriate investigations and interpretation
- Perform various diagnostic investigations and make management plan
- Debate the advantages, disadvantages, indications, contra-indications, limitations and complications of the current treatment modalities and justifying the use of each by best available evidence.
- Formulate management plans in partnership with patients according to standardization.
- Advice and counsel the patient and their family members
- Educate the patient regarding the health problem, available choices, management plan, self-care, and use of prescribed drugs and equipment.
- Recognize and take into consideration issues of equality, equity and diversity
- Describe and debate the reasons for the success or failures of various approaches to increase prevention and to decrease social inequities
- Manage time and prioritize tasks and use of resources.
- Ensure patient safety always including strict infection control practices.

COMPETENCE OF MEDICAL GRADUATES

KNOWLEDGEABLE (SCIENTIFIC KNOWLEDGE FOR GOOD MEDICAL PRACTICE)

This embodies knowledge of basic medical and clinical sciences required for the practice of medicine.

COMMUNITY HEALTH PROMOTER (KNOWLEDGE OF POPULATION HEALTH AND HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS)

To deal with problems of population-based primary health care, including health promotion and disease prevention with special emphasis on vulnerable populations. Medical graduates require knowledge of population health and healthcare systems. The graduates should understand their role and be able to take appropriate action for protecting and promoting the health of populations.

CRITICAL THINKER (PROBLEM SOLVING AND REFLECTIVE PRACTICE)

The ability to critically evaluate existing knowledge, technology and information, and to be able to reflect on it, is necessary for solving problems.

PROFESSIONAL (BEHAVIOR AND PROFESSIONALISM)

Competent medical graduates require professional values, attitudes and behaviors that embody good medical practice i.e., life-long learning, altruism, empathy, cultural and religious sensitivity, honesty, accountability, probity, ethics, communication skills, and team work. The medical graduates should be cognizant of the PMC competencies. Graduates should be role models of their code of conduct, professionalism and values, on and off duty, throughout their lives, and thus lead by example, in order to justify the trust reposed in them by public. Their behavior must enhance public trust in the profession.

Life-long Self-directed Learner

Medical graduates must continually acquire new scientific knowledge and skills to maintain competence and incorporate it into their day-to-day medical practice. For life-long learning, they should demonstrate a desire for continuing medical education during their professional life through personal development activities to continuously acquiring and using advance knowledge and technologies.

Altruistic and Empathetic

Medical graduates should be able to demonstrate professional values of empathy, altruism and cultural sensitivity in arranging or coordinating the best possible care.

Ethical

Medical graduates should be able to demonstrate professional values of self and professional accountability, honesty, probity, and ethics.

Collaborator

The medical graduate should be able to demonstrate skills of teamwork to best serve the interests of the patient, profession and institution by:

- Working as an effective team member, understanding the importance of each role.

COMPETENCE OF MEDICAL GRADUATES

- Demonstrating collegiality and respect for juniors, peers, seniors and the healthcare team.
- Continuously assessing themselves and others in their roles and acting accordingly.
- Sharing information and handing over care appropriately.
- Focusing on a collegial but problem-solving approach.

Communicator

The medical graduates should be able to demonstrate:

- Non-Verbal communication skills
- Verbal communication skills
- Written and electronic communication skills
- Confidentiality
- Dissemination of information and research

SCHOLAR & RESEARCHER

The medical graduates are expected to demonstrate constructive criticism, a spirit of enquiry, creativity and research-oriented attitude.

LEADER AND ROLE MODEL

The medical graduates are expected to demonstrate exemplary conduct and leadership potential in:

- Advancing healthcare.
- Enhancing medical education.
- Initiating, participating in and adapting to change, using scientific evidence and approaches.
- Enhancing the trust of the public in medical and dental profession by being exceptional role models at work and also when away.
- Accepting leadership roles if required.
- Providing leadership in issues concerning society.

INTRODUCTION OF THE COLLEGE



Akhtar Saeed Medical & Dental College, (AMDC) Lahore was established in 2008. It was inspected and granted permission to train 100-medical students with effect from academic session 2008-09 by Pakistan Medical and Dental council (PM & DC), Islamabad. Now by the grace of Almighty Allah, Pakistan Medical & Dental Council has recommended Akhtar Saeed Medical & Dental College to train up to 150 medical students with effect from academic session 2012-13

The AMDC is situated in the south-west of Lahore in the picturesque area of Bahria Town, on the national highway from Lahore to Multan. The building of medical college is majestic and inspiring for visitors. All the seven basic departments are purpose built, having well equipped laboratories. Four lecture theaters (each with a capacity of 150 seats), four tutorial rooms (each with a capacity of 100 seats) and an auditorium having a capacity of 540 audience are fully equipped with multimedia and modern audiovisual aids. The auditorium is used for general assembly of students, symposia, seminars, clinico-pathological and other conferences. Skill lab having facilities for practical training of students is also available.



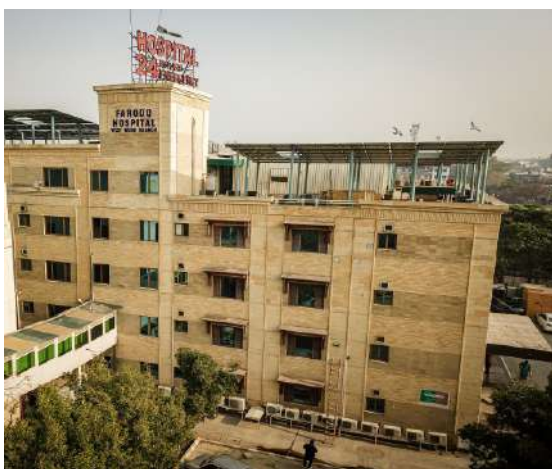
Akhtar Saeed Trust Teaching Hospital

The main affiliated tertiary care hospital of the medical college. It is a charitable hospital having all the specialties required for undergraduate medical education. The hospital is governed by the board of trustees of Akhtar Saeed Trust (a body duly constituted under the law). It is situated in DHA EME Sector. It is a purpose built four-storied building. It has the capacity of more than 300 patients. All the major clinical departments are established in this hospital. These include department of Medicine, Surgery, Gynaecology & Obstetrics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Dentistry, Psychiatry, Dermatology, Paediatrics, Radiology and Physiotherapy. More than 500 patients are attended in outdoor daily.



Farooq Teaching Hospital (Allama Iqbal Town)

The other affiliated 120 bedded teaching hospital of the college. It is situated in Allama Iqbal Town Lahore near new campus of University of the Punjab, Lahore. This hospital has modern diagnostic and therapeutic facilities including MRI, C.T Scan, Echocardiography, ETT, Emergency Room, PCR Lab, well equipped pathology laboratory, ICU, CCU and NICU. Recently 40 beds are added. A purpose built lecture hall has also been added for teaching and holding various seminars.



Farooq Teaching Hospital (Westwood Society)

A most modern and high end hospital established in 2012, affiliated with Akhtar Saeed Medical & Dental College Pvt. Ltd. (AMDC) located at beautiful canal road, West Wood Colony, Thokar Niaz Baig, Lahore. This 230 bedded hospital is established to offer supreme medical services and fully equipped with all latest diagnostic & surgical facilities. This hospital has five general teaching wards, along with a lecture theater of 150 sitting capacity for teaching of medical students. **Specialities include** Angiography, Angioplasty, Bypass Surgery, Peripheral angioplasty, Pace Maker, Echocardiography, MRI, CT Scan, Color Doppler, Mammography, OPG, ERCP, Fistula Making, Haemodialysis, Platelets Concentration, Bone Marrow, Trauma & Spine Centre etc.

LIVING AT AMDC



The medical college has appropriate number of furnished rooms to provide hostel accommodation to the students, intending to reside in hostel. Separate hostel accommodation is built for boys and girls. Mess facilities will also be provided in the hostel for boys and girls separately.

Administrative structure of Hostels

There is a warden of hostels assisted by assistant wardens. Student's management committee looks after hostel messes in consultation with wardens/ assistant wardens.

• Hostel Rules and Regulation

- The student will abide by rules promulgated by the principal from time to time.
- Students are not allowed to keep fire arms or narcotics in their rooms in hostels.
- Unauthorized students will not be allowed to live in the hostels. If such case is reported strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who accommodated unauthorized guests.
- No female guest is allowed in the boy's hostels and no male guest is allowed in the girl's hostels under any circumstances.
- Each Boarder will pay all hostel and mess dues by a specified date. Defaulters will not be allowed to live in the hostel.
- Any student guilty of misconduct and violation of hostel rules will be expelled from hostel by principal on advice of the warden of hostels.
- The students will be responsible for paying extra dues for additional use of electric appliances like air conditioner, refrigerators, microwave ovens etc.

Mess Management System

- The warden has appointed separate mess committees and prefects to supervise the mess of the hostels each for Boys & Girls.
- The assistant warden ensures appropriate excellent standard of cleanliness and standard of food in mess.
- Proper record of meals taken by the student and payments made by them is maintained by the mess manager / contractor.
- The principal exercises his/her discretionary power to rectify any problem being faced by students regarding hostel mess.

Timings of the Boys Hostels

All students should be present in their rooms by 10:00 p.m. Assistant Warden (or his representative) will check the presence of students in their rooms at 10:15 p.m. The name of absent students will be reported to warden.

Special Rules for the Girls Hostels

All girl students should be present in hostel rooms/premises by 8:00 p.m. They shall provide a list of visitors duly approved by their parents or guardian to the Assistant Warden. A record register of departure & arrival will be maintained by the assistant warden to observe timings of girl's students going out of hostel in afternoon.

Visit of the City for Boarder Students

For visit of the city, specific days are fixed for the boys and girls, and college transport will be used for the purpose. The students are also taken to Bahria Town market twice a week on college transport.

Duties of the Warden

- Warden carries out the implementation of hostel policy as prescribed.
- He is responsible for overall discipline in the hostels.
- He takes all steps to make hostels as comfortable for students as possible.
- He arranges indoor games in the hostel and encourage healthy interaction among students.
- He ensures best quality arrangements for student's mess.
- He keeps close scrutiny on hostel accounts relating to mess and general store items.

Duties of the Assistant Warden

- They carry out policies of Principal and Warden regarding hostels.
- They assist the warden in maintenance of discipline in the hostel and ensure that all students are in their rooms by a specific time at night.
- They report all infringements of discipline immediately to the warden.
- They ensure excellent sanitary conditions in the hostels and the messes.
- They prepare duty rosters of hostel servants.

LIBRARY SERVICES

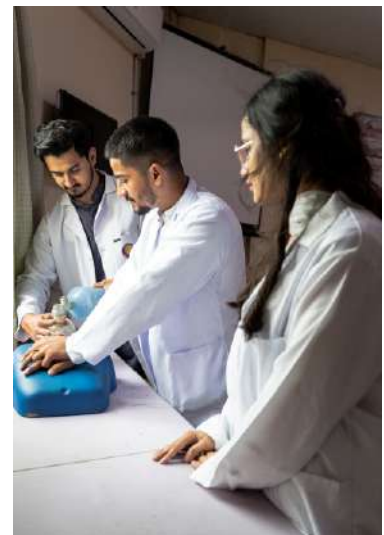

ADMISSIONS

Admission policy

Akhtar Saeed Medical & Dental College, Lahore (ASMDC) follows the admission policy issued by the Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC). For admission to medical colleges, each Province or territory shall determine the merit structure based on the student having qualified the MDCAT at 55% for admission to medical colleges and 45% for admission to dental colleges. ASMDC will frame its individual merit criteria for admission subject to PMC admission regulations.

Eligibility for Admission

Any person seeking admission in any undergraduate medical or dental college in Pakistan shall be eligible having fulfilled the following mandatory criteria:

- Have passed the MDCAT examination.
- Obtained a Higher Secondary School Certificate qualification ("HSSC") or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan and having obtained more than sixty percent marks therein, or a higher percentage as may be notified by the Medical and Dental Council;
- Passed the subjects of biology and chemistry and either physics or mathematics in the examination of the Higher Secondary School Certificate or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan

• From Foreign Medical College:

All students in foreign medical/ dental colleges who wish to migrate to Pakistan can now register themselves online for NEB exam.

On qualifying the NEB exam, all such students can apply immediately for admission in Medical/Dental Colleges in Pakistan on vacant seats for the Session 2022-23 in the relevant year.

No foreign migration will be entertained without qualifying the NEB exam.

Medical fitness requirements at the time of admission

- The candidates who have been selected provisionally shall be examined medically by a medical board to be constituted by Principal of AMDC.
- The selected candidate must produce certificate of having been:

- Inoculated against typhoid fever within preceding twelve months.
- Fully vaccinated against tetanus.
- Fully vaccinated against Hepatitis "B".
- All candidates must produce certificate stating his/her serological status of HCV & HBV, HIV & COVID-19 Certification.
- The list of selected applicants for admission in AMDC will be notified after medical fitness examination and having passed aptitude test/interview of AMDC Lahore.

Interview Pattern

• The Multiple Mini-Interview

Interviews are one of the opportunities for AMDC to assess the applicants in person. Candidates have reached this stage because of their sufficiently high academic standing. AMDC selected Multiple Mini-Interview (MMI) as an admissions interview tool.

• Operational Details

- Each mini-interview takes place on different stations.
- When the applicant comes to the station, he/she will greet and introduce himself/herself.
- The applicant then will see a card with few lines describing the scenario.
- The applicants will have three minutes for each station and will be told when they may enter the station.
- The applicants will be assessed on the following skills like ethical decision making, communication skills, collaboration/task oriented, leadership skills, time management, stress management and personal interviews.

DISCIPLINE

In order to keep an atmosphere of serenity and calmness in the medical college, hostel and teaching hospitals following disciplinary rules will be enforced.

Contribution of Disciplinary Committee

- A Disciplinary Committee (DC) shall be constituted by the principal. The committee shall be comprised of minimum one or more Professors and one or more Associate / Assistant Professors. The principal shall have the power to re-constitute Disciplinary Committee from time to time.

Function of Disciplinary Committee

- Any major act of indiscipline committed by a student/group of students will be brought to the notice of the Principal, and referred to the chairman of the Disciplinary Committee. The DC will conduct a detailed inquiry into the matter and submits its findings and recommendations to the principal.
- The principal will implement the recommendations of DC. However, the principal shall have the power to decrease or amend the punishment recommended by the DC.

Punishment in Disciplinary Committee

- The various forms of the punishments which may be awarded are as follows:
 - A written warning to be careful in future.
 - Suspension from the college roll for a period of 14 days.
 - Imposition of fine up to Rs. 10,000/- depending on the gravity of the indiscipline.
 - Expulsion from the hostels.
 - Expulsion from the college for six months to two years.
 - Rustication and permanently striking off the college roll and never to be admitted in the college.
 - The cases of infliction of injuries, major theft, possession of weapons/firearms, arson or homicide, will be referred to the laws enforcing agencies for proceedings according to the law of the country.

Vigilance Committee

- Minor acts of breach of discipline will be referred to a Vigilance Committee for probing and deciding punishments. The Vigilance Committee will also supervise the students with regard to their behavior in the college, observance of the dress code and bunking of classes, etc. The Vigilance Committee shall consist of at least one Professor and one or more Associate/Assistant Professors.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

- The student will abide by rules promulgated by the Principal from time to time.
- Students are not allowed to keep fire arms or narcotics in their rooms in hostels.
- Students are required to observe the following rules during the course of their studies at the college.
- Unauthorized students/outsideers will not be allowed to live in the hostels. If such case is reported strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who accommodated unauthorized guests.

DISCIPLINE

- No female guest is allowed in the boy's hostels and no male guest is allowed in the girl's hostels under any circumstances.
- Each Boarder will pay all hostel and mess dues by a specified date. Defaulters will not be allowed to live in the hostel.
- Any student guilty of misconduct and violation of hostel rules will be expelled from the hostel by the principal an advice of the warden of hostels.
- The students will be responsible for paying extra dues for additional use at electric appliances like air conditioner, refrigerators, microwave ovens etc.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Students are required to observe the following rules during the course of their studies at the college.

- Students will not be allowed to keep any guest in the college hostel without the prior written approval from the competent authority i.e., warden hostels or Principal. However, it should be noted that no female guest can be kept in the boy's hostels and no male guest can be kept in girl's hostels under any circumstances whatsoever,
- Students are forbidden from indulging in any political, partisan or sectarian activity in the college and its affiliated hospitals, or in the hostels.
- Unauthorized absence from class will be considered as a serious breach of conduct. In case of illness, students will be required to submit a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- Students commuting by the college transport are required to maintain discipline in the vehicles while commuting to and from the college. Any damage caused to the transport by students will result in severe action, including but not limiting to paying the cost of necessary repairs.
- Any damage caused to the property of the college or affiliated teaching hospitals & hostels which include laboratory equipment, furniture & fixtures, canteen, library books, Plantation etc. or any other thing in the premises of AMDC, will be considered as serious act of indiscipline and student will be asked to compensate as determined by appropriate authority.
- It is mandatory for all students to remain in college premises during working hours. Anybody venturing out in the surrounding areas will do so at his/her own risk and will be liable for necessary disciplinary action.
- It is mandatory for all students to wear overall coat and must display their college ID cards in college premises.
- Chalking is strictly prohibited and necessary action will be taken against those students who are found indulged in doing so.
- Drug abuse and Smoking is strictly prohibited in college, hostel premises & affiliated hospitals.
- Student must follow the dress code of the college, as notified by the college administration from time to time. Violation of college dress code will result in disciplinary action against the defaulters.
- The students found misbehaving with any faculty member or the administrative staff will be dealt with as per disciplinary rules.
- Use of social media inside or outside of college premises against the college administration, faculty members, and fellow students is strictly prohibited. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students who are involved in these mentioned activities.

PHYSIOLOGY

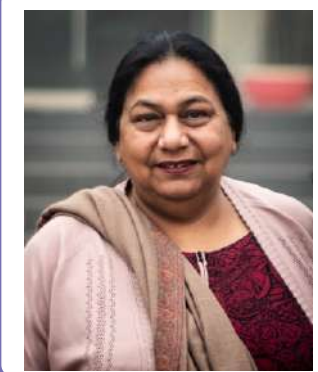

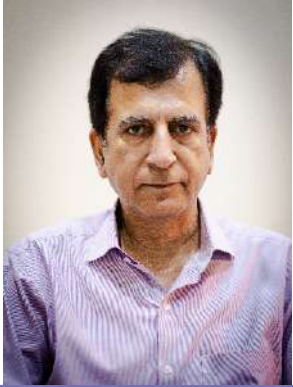

Pharmacology is an essential component of the modern undergraduate and postgraduate medical curricula and a number of other disciplines like nursing, pharmacy, dentistry veterinary medicine etc. To fighting diseases with drugs is as old as man. The undergraduate teaching program in basic and clinical pharmacology provides students with scientific base of its application. The curricula are designed to brace the students with the clinical significance of learning the subject. The subject matter is delivered through:



- Lectures
- Tutorials
- Small group Discussions
- Experimental Work
- Presentations
- Audio-visual help
- Internet access
- Seminars / Symposiums

The student and teaching faculty are equally assessed by feed-back system in the college. The students achieve the capability to appear in international examinations like USMLE, PLAB etc. They are given short essay questions, multiple choice questions, OSPE/OSCE, Basic Pharmacy Practicals, introductory knowledge of experimental pharmacology Practical in intact animals/isolated tissues and human beings. The students also learn the basic principles of Research Methodology and Biostatistics. At the end of session they are able to write a prescription and can manage drug toxicity. Clinical pharmacology is focused on clinical relevance of the theoretical knowledge. Students are given field work to collect information about the drugs & related diseases.



The Department of Pharmacology in Akhter Saeed Medical College comprises of commodious lecture theatres, laboratory, museum and demonstration room which are equipped with latest audio-visual teaching aids. PATHOLOGY

Pathology is a discipline that provides diagnostic information to the clinicians. It impacts nearly all aspects of patient care ranging from diagnosing and managing cancer to the chronic diseases. Pathology comprises of Microbiology, General and Special Pathology. The aim is to produce clinicians with better understanding of the disease process so that they objectively use diagnostic tool designed to help them reach a conclusive diagnosis in the shortest possible time. The curriculum therefore covers every known aspect of modern day investigations being carried out across the globe.



The Department consist of following sections:

Pathology Museum, Demonstration Room, Histopathology diagnostic & teaching laboratory, Chemical Pathology laboratory, Hematology laboratory and Microbiology laboratory. The specimens include Biopsies, FNACs of cytological fluids received from Akhtar Saeed Trust Teaching Hospital, Farooq Teaching Hospital Allama Iqbal Town, Lahore and Farooq Teaching Hospital Westwood Colony, Lahore.

Pathology department holds CME, related to current Pathological problems every week to train the Junior staff members.

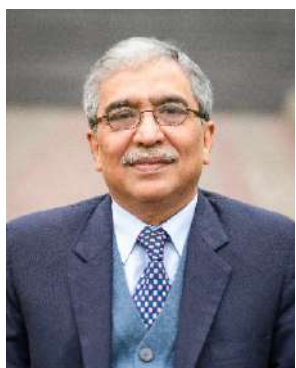

The infrastructure of Ophthalmology Department consists of a major eye operation theater (within the main surgical operating complex). It is equipped with a state-of-the-art operating microscope with video camera for recording, research and teaching purpose with the large LCD screen, two-way microphone communication systems between students and the surgeon for live surgical demonstration and teaching. All anterior segment surgeries, such as glaucoma surgery and cataract surgery, are performed using a state-of-the-art phaco system. Squint assessment and surgery, enucleation and evisceration with orbital implants and amniotic membrane grafts for surface eye diseases, surgeries for the lid and lacrimal system are performed too. The outpatient clinic is adequately equipped to provide ambulatory care to patients and teaching facilities for the medical students who start attending the hospital from 3rd MBBS year for their eye disease teaching and training. In OPD we have teaching digital slit lamp which is important for student teaching programs. The eye department has the latest investigational tool like octopus visual field analyzer, Hess screen, ocular ultrasound, Fundus Fluorescien angiography, optical coherent tomography, 532 lasers for treating retinal diseases. With these machines we are providing diagnosis and treatment of medical retina like diabetic retinopathy, retinal veins occlusions and age-related macular degeneration. Glaucoma and secondary cataract are being treated with YAG laser machines. All the facilities are provided free of cost to the patient at Akther Saeed Trust Hospital EME society Lahore. Research and publication are important in medical education; eye department has published 29 papers in past 7 years. Students are encouraged to participate in data collection and paper writing.

The Department of Medicine is an important component of Akhtar Saeed Medical & Dental College Bahria Town Lahore. There are three teaching hospitals attached with the college, Akhtar Saeed Trust Teaching Hospital situated in EME-DHA Housing Society, Farooq Hospital in Allama Iqbal Town Lahore and Farooq Hospital in Westwood Colony Lahore. The infrastructure consists of Emergency ward, outdoor, Indoor departments, Intensive Care Unit/High Dependency Unit, Endoscopy and Bronchoscopy facilities.

The Laboratory & Radiology Departments provide good diagnostic support in Akhtar Saeed Trust Teaching Hospital and above mentioned two Farooq Hospitals have all modern facilities like C.T Scan, MRI, Doppler Ultrasound Studies, Echocardiography and ETT for patients. SURGERY

The field of surgery is an integral part of training and teaching of MBBS curriculum. A specific number of hours are allocated in the pre clinical years of MBBS curriculum. The clinical training starts from the 3rd year and continues in 4th year and final year.

Over the years the field of surgery has expanded many folds. New specialties have been introduced. However general surgery remains the mother of all the fields. Without exposure to general surgery the training of the students even at the post graduate level remains deficient.



The undergraduate students during their rotation in surgery learn basic principles of surgical management. They are trained in the management of trauma and emergency surgical procedures. In addition systemic surgery is an essential component of this field.

Department of Surgery Akhtar Saeed Medical and Dental College has chalked out a very comprehensive and elaborate programme for training and teaching its students.

The students appear in the subject of the surgery after this intensive training of five years in final professional examination.

Units and Teaching Hospitals

The department of surgery Akhtar Saeed Medical and Dental College Lahore is established at Akhtar Saeed Trust Teaching Hospital, Farooq Teaching Hospital Allama Iqbal Town & Farooq Teaching Hospital West Wood Branch Lahore.

The department is divided into three units. Unit - I, Unit - II and Unit-III.

The department consists of 120 beds which are distributed in all the teaching hospital.

1. Akhtar Saeed Trust Teaching Hospital It is situated in EME colony, DHA Multan Road, Lahore.

Indoor: The department of surgery is located on the first floor. Total number of beds are 64. Male ward consists of 38 beds while female ward has 28 beds. In intensive care unit (ICU) 03 beds are attached with the Department of Surgery.

There is a demonstration room for the teaching of the students. In addition the students are given demonstration in the wards as well as in the out patient department. The operation theater complex is situated on the ground floor. It is fully equipped with all the necessary equipments. The department operates thrice per week.

Out patient department is situated in the basement with proper offices and reception areas for the patients. The department of emergency is established at the basement with a minor Operation theater (MOT) to carry out various procedures. It consists of 04 beds. Surgical emergencies are received and managed round the clock.

2. Farooq Teaching Hospital It is situated in the midst of the commercial area of Allama Iqbal Town, Lahore.

Emergency department of this hospital is fully equipped for receiving various emergency or including orthopedics, neuro surgical and urological emergency. Operation theaters, are fully equipped for performing various types of surgical procedures including general surgery, orthopedics, neurosurgery, pediatric, urological surgery, plastic surgery. 20 beds are allocated for the surgical sub specialty patients including Orthopedic, Neurosurgery & Plastic surgery.

3. Farooq Teaching Hospital West Wood Branch.

The department of surgery is located in the basement. 56 beds are allocated for the surgical department. Male ward consists of 30 beds while 26 beds are allocated for female patients.

There is a demonstration room for the teaching of the students. In addition the students are given demonstration in the wards as well as in the out patients department. There is a lecture theater with capacity of 150 students which is attached with operation complex by audio visual system.

The operation theatre complex is situated on the first floor which is fully equipped with all the necessary equipments.

Out patient department is situated in the basement with proper offices and reception areas for the patients.

The department of emergency is established at the basement with a minor Operation theatre (MOT) to carry out various procedures. It consists of 08 beds. Surgical emergencies are received and managed round the clock.

The Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology provides services to all the patients who present in emergency & outpatient department. Free health services and Emergency services are available round the clock.

Department of obstetrics and gynecology comprises of two units headed by Prof Dr. Fariha Farooq. Gynae unit 1 at Akhtar Saeed Trust Hospital, EME, Lahore. is headed by Prof Dr Ambreen Mumtaz. Hospital is providing free of cost gynecological and obstetric services for last 18 years including free meals to the patients. Gynae unit 2 at Farooq Hospital Westwood colony, Lahore, is headed by Prof Dr. Naheed Jamal Faruqi.

The department has obstetric and gynecology wards, labour rooms, fully equipped operation theaters, neonatal resuscitation room and demonstration rooms for students. The classrooms have all audio-visual aids and teaching aids like illuminator, dummies, pictorial charts and white board. We deal with variety of obstetric and gynecology patients and it provides a clinical material for medical students to learn clinical skills.

The outpatient department deals with antenatal care of high risk patients, infertility services, family planning services, menopause problems and urogynaecological problems and oncology.

The department deals with all type of surgeries including major and minor obstetric and gynaecological procedures and diagnostic and operative hysteroscopies & Laparoscopies. There is a central blood bank to cater the emergency needs of the patient. Anesthesia, services for painless vaginal delivery and neonatal facilities are also available.

All the advanced diagnostic facilities like color Doppler ultrasound, TVS, MRI & CT Scan are also available.

There is a departmental library and unit has access to internet facility and central library in the hospital.

Annual turnover of Obstetric procedures is 1500 and gynecological procedures is 500

Department is involved in undergraduate teaching programme since 2011 and post graduate training & teaching programme recognized by CPSP for the last 11 years.

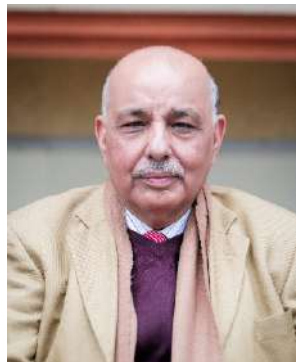

This department comprises of

- Indoor 40 beds including 5 beds in PICU and 10 beds for well equipped NICU.
- Out patient facility, attended by regular pediatric trained medical officers, and is supervised by senior consultants on regular basis
- Pediatric emergency room attended by pediatric trained postgraduate students of FCPS and house officers round the clock 24 hours a day and seven day a week.
- Medical Student Teaching: This department has full expertise and staff for teaching undergraduates and post graduate medical students.

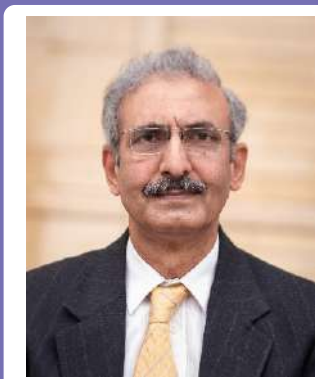

RADIOLOGY

The Department of Radiology at Akhtar Saeed Medical and Dental College provides a complete range of Diagnostic and treatment related imaging services. We offer 24/7 services that accommodate the needs of inpatients, outpatients and outside referrals by providing the best possible modern diagnostic facilities. Our skilled team of specialists use state-of-the-art equipment to provide high-quality imaging and image-guided treatments in a caring, safe and efficient environment. Radiology services are equipped with two latest MRI



machines (1) 1.5T Espree MRI and (2) Siemens Open MRI 0.4 tesla, four CT Scanners (3) 128CXL slice CT scanners (1) 16 slice RXL, Fluoroscopy, 18 state of the art Modern ultrasound machines with several having specialized facility of Shear Wave Elastography, Echocardiography, 4D & Doppler imaging. The facility of Mammography, Dexa Scan and OPG are also available.

The general radiography procedures inclusive of IVP and Fluoroscopy are carried out on Computed Radiography System (CR) and Digital Retrofit (DR) which has minimized the patient waiting time and radiation dose. The Institute has 9 Modern Digital Fluoro C-ARMS to assist in Intraoperative imaging. There are total five Digital Subtraction Angiography (DSA) machines including 2 BI-plane systems with highly skilled Interventional radiology team, which provide a wide range of diagnostic & therapeutic procedures including vascular & non vascular interventions.

There are 8 Mobile X-ray systems to enhance patient imaging in the Intensive care Environment. The Department is moving towards film-less radiology and is fortified with effective Picture Archiving and Communicating System (PACS).

The department possesses a team of highly qualified Radiologists, Research faculty, highly qualified (MID) and experienced/trained team of radiographers & IT support staff, making it one of the leading teachings & post graduate training department in the region. All our facilities have resulted in enhanced quality of patient care and Farooq group of hospitals is pioneer in online reporting From Abroad which is Accomplished within the shortest span of time to facilitate patient diagnosis and treatment.
